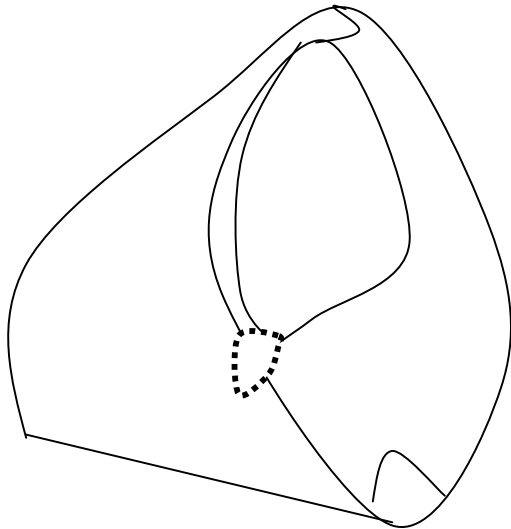


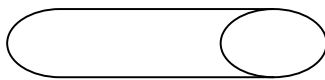
ORIGAMI FOLD BAG (p 2 of 2)

SUGGESTIONS : Add magnetic closure inside lining; add interior pockets; add bag feet.

Makes up equally well in yarn or Sakiori (torn/cut fabric strips e.g. Sari silk etc)

Join tops of triangles (overlap) to make handle - **See option C** below first!

OPTIONS:

A. Make braid or use commercial product for closure loop. Vintage buttons, self-covered buttons, wooden buttons all work well.

B. Fold UP triangular segment at both sides of bag to create a flat base for the bag. Stitch by machine or strong hand stitching to secure.

C. Stitch tube of fabric (e.g. same as lining) and slip over handle area **BEFORE** stitching handles together. This will act as reinforcement and protection, strengthening the pressure point where the handles connect. This tube of fabric can also be used to **LENGTHEN** handles by directing stitching the handle "points" into the tube instead of to each other.
